



DCIA P3P Working Group (P3PWG) Membership

The P3P Working Group (P3PWG) was established in January 2009 at the request of DCIA Member the Isle of Man, with the support of other DCIA Members, to be conducted under the auspices of the DCIA pursuant to the trade association's guidelines for such activities.

Membership in the P3PWG is initially organized in four Groups: 1) Internet and Mobile Service Providers (ISPs); 2) Music Recording and Publishing Content Rights Holders (CRHs); 3) Licensed Digital Music Delivery Services and Bundled Hardware Product Offerings (DMOs); and 4) Peer-to-Peer and Other File-Sharing Software Distributors (P2Ps).

Qualifications for participation in the P3PWG are that the primary business of prospective participants be one of the above four categories. For such P3PWG participants, there is no cost to participate in the P3PWG and no pre-requisite for acceptance into the P3PWG, such as DCIA Membership.

The P3PWG is open to all ISPs, CRHs, DMOs, and P2Ps on a global basis, subject only to the approval of P3PWG leadership.

In addition, DCIA Member companies in good standing are entitled as a privilege of Membership to participate in the P3PWG.
